

# Preparation of Digital files for Club Competitions

Entries for digitally projected Club competitions should be supplied, on CD-R disc, in the following format:

**Colour space** sRGB

**Image Size** - no more than 1400 pixels in width and no more than 1050 pixels in height.

**File format** jpeg

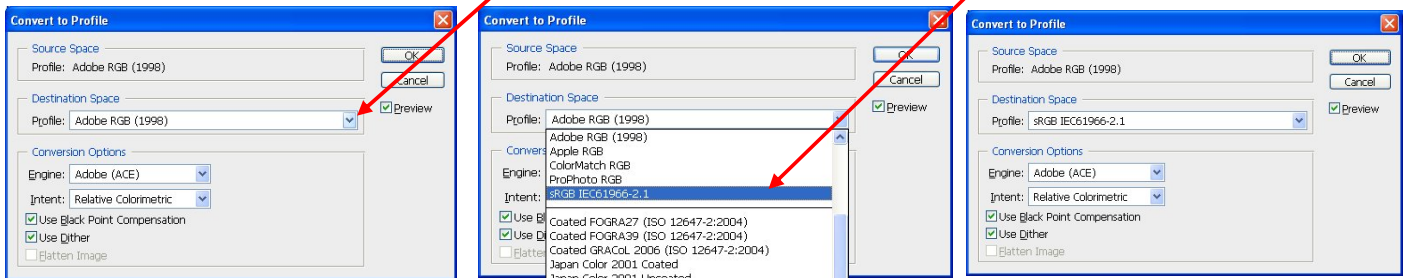
These notes are offered as basic guidance for members who may require some assistance.

Open the image in your image processing software and make any adjustments required.

## 1. Set the colour space to sRGB

To do this, click on **Edit** then **Convert to Profile...**

In this dialogue box, click on the Destination Space and for Profile choose **sRGB IEC61966-2.1** ...



Click OK to convert your file to the sRGB colour space.

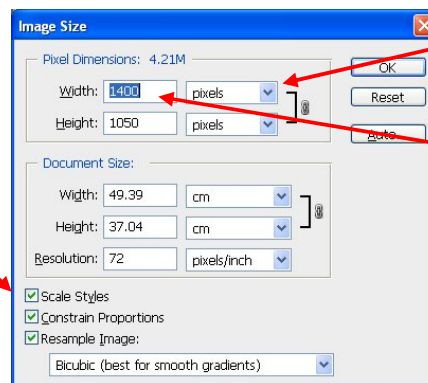
Please note that your image may, or may not, require further colour correction at this stage.

## 2. Resize the Image

To do this, click on **Image** then **Image Size**

In this dialogue box:

Ensure that the 'Constraints' and other boxes are ticked.



Ensure that pixels is specified in both height and width boxes.

If your image is in *landscape format* then enter 1400 in the width box and check that the height is no more than 1050.

If your image is in *portrait or square format* then enter 1050 in the height box.

Click OK to resize to the dimensions chosen.

## 3. Save the file as a jpeg

To do this, click on **File** then **Save** or **Save As**

Under Filename, enter the number and name of your image.

Click on Format and choose JPEG

In this dialogue box, choose Quality Maximum, then OK to save the file.
